Pinnacle Academy's staff recognizes the opportunity to give our students practical learning tools to succeed and become scholars. We also have relevant Technology courses and seminars that include African American History, voter education, personal finance, wealth management, public health, and holistic wellness seminars. Our students have an Academic Advisor who acts as a guide for student success. We teach students to become independent learners acquiring problem-solving skills.

APPLICATION PROCESS

APPLICATION Process

To Attend Pinnacle Academy, each student must complete the following steps:

- ◆ Complete an Application form and pay the non-refundable processing Fee \$25 for each student
- ◆ Provide student transcripts from the previous school
- ◆ Select Enrollment type (Full-time, Part-time = Max 3 courses/year, or a Single Course)
- ◆ Pay Student Registration fee and select a payment plan
- ◆ Take grade-level English and Math Assessment tests (6th grade and above)
- ◆ Parent and Student sign the Pinnacle Academy Parent/Student Contract
- Meet with an Academic Advisor to confirm selected courses
- ◆ Receive Parent and Student Portal
- ◆ Complete Parent/Student orientation successfully

ASSESSMENT AND EVALUATIONS

Assessments help students know what areas they need work. Academic Advisors evaluate assessments at the beginning of a course and then again at the end. The hope is that students will show vast improvements upon course completion. The evaluation from the data collected helps create a statistical report on our student progression. Students must complete assessments before the course assignment

Our courses are activity-based. Instruction and examples help students complete tasks by following the practice examples provided for each section. Tasks are complete after students have given enough correct answers to be considered proficient.

Academic Expectations. Pinnacle Academy expects honesty and integrity among its students and partners. Students must adhere to rules of conduct prescribed in this document and listed on the website under School Policies.

Full-Time Enrollment (Available for K-12) gives students access to the entire course catalog for their grade level. We give our full-time students the opportunity to use an entire 12 months to successfully complete a grade.




Grades 9-12 students are enrolled in core (Math, English, Science, Social Studies), all accredited courses. Students can still choose to work with a live teacher or work independently.

Part-time Enrollment is an excellent choice for students who need to make up credits and missing unit requirements for graduation. Part-time enrollment gives students limited access, with a maximum of 3 courses per year; similarly, single course students can select one course per year. Part-time enrollment is only available to students in grades 7-12.

ACADEMICS

Pinnacle Academy allows all full-time students flexibility. Students can choose to take one class at a time or multiple courses at once. Academic Advisors and students set up a course schedule that is practical for the student.

Students meet one on one with Academic Advisor. The Academic Advisor ensures assignments/tasks are complete on time. Our activity-based curriculum creates a foundation of core concepts that will build blocks for each educational level.



ILM Independent Learning Module

ILM is developed for students to complete coursework and assignments independently.

Students follow the course of study at a pace created by students in concert with their Academic Advisor. We track each ILM student's progress. The Academic Advisor acts as a guide for students as they prepare for college. Our goal is to allow students to achieve their success without distractions.

To promote social interaction, ILM students must participate in group assemblies and projects throughout the school year. To qualify for ILM, students must test at grade level in one or more academic areas (mathematics or English) and have a parent's signature.

LIVE TEACHER

LTM Live Teacher Module

The LTM Module provides a transition from brick and mortar to an online and independent practice of learning.

The LTM allows each student to attend scheduled live teacher sessions Monday—Thursday. Fridays are for independent assignments, assemblies, group projects, and group study.

- LTM students are instructed by our Learning Coaches or in a Virtual online session with a maximum of 4 students.
- LTM students also have an Academic Advisor that tracks their progress and communicates academic successes to both student and parent.

Education Plus



Education Plus is our education model designed for students who typically need extra help through tutoring. Our EPM students work on an LTM schedule with the added benefit of a professional tutoring service partner. Each full-time EPM student has access to up to 48 hours of one-on-one tutoring to last all 12 months of the year.

EPM Students can pay for additional tutoring for \$50/hour.

Just Tutoring: Any Pinnacle student can request tutoring. From the Pinnacle Academy Website, select the Education Plus Module EPM. Click on the calendar to choose the date and time that works best for you. Answer a few questions about the subject and submit the form to receive a confirmation link to the tutoring session. Payment is due before the session begins.

Provide live online instruction and support to students in our Live Teacher Module, LTM. Student/LC ratio is 4 to 1.

Academic Advisor (AA)


COLLEGE AFTER PINNACLE ACADEMY

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

- ILM PE Physical education is a requirement in the United States. Full-time students take Physical Education through the 10th grade or fulfill the physical requirements by joining an extra-curricular sport to complete an activity log that parent or guardian must sign.
- Group PE is the social model which requires students to log in to a monitored classroom with a live instructor and other students. Exercise in a group can be a fun activity for students who don't want to exercise alone. Our online sessions cost \$30/week. For more information, speak to an Academic Advisor for a recommendation.

PINNACLE ACADEMY STUDENT SOCIETY (PASS)

Pinnacle Academy recognizes quality education and socializing are both critical components to student success. Our online student union, PASS, is where students access their school dashboard, sign up for social clubs, and join assembly groups monitored by our staff.

Additionally, all Pinnacle Academy students, including our independent learners, have scheduled group meetings, group projects, virtual field trips, and other online assemblies to promote healthy socializing.

Full-time Students:

- **6-8) grade** must take <u>5 core courses:</u> English, Math, Social Studies, Science, PE but can take up to 2 electives.
- **(9-10) grade** must take <u>5 core courses:</u> English, Math, Social Studies, Science, World Language & PE and 1 or more electives.
- (11-12) grade must take <u>4 core courses:</u>
 English, Math, Social Studies, Science and 1 or more electives and Health, plus complete the senior project to graduate.



Group Discounts

Full-time students can opt to pay over 10 months, 12 months, or receive a 3% discount for tuition paid in full within 30 days.
